Thank you for your letter to the Hon Mike Baird MP, Premier of NSW, requesting information to inform your assessment of the operation of section 35P of the *Australian Security and Intelligence Organisation Act 1979* (ASIO Act). As the matters you have raised largely fall within my administration, your letter has been referred to me for reply.

Relevant agencies have provided the following information in response to your request:

- The Bureau of Crime Statistics and Research advises that there have been no finalised charges for disclosure offences with respect to controlled operations or to a person's assumed identity, under the *Law Enforcement (Controlled Operations) Act 1997* and the *Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Act 2010*.
- The Independent Commission Against Corruption advises that there have been no matters referred for prosecution under the above Acts.
- The Ministry for Police and Emergency Services advises that, in relation to reports made regarding instances of wrongdoing, or conduct in excess of relevant authority, information can be found in the NSW Ombudsman's Annual Reports and the Law Enforcement (Controlled Operations) Act Annual Reports.
